at Callaway Church of God.

One of these speakers, Sharam Hadian, spoke about ‘Building a Secure Patriotic Network’ based on governing bodies established by the colonists to America. Hadian was instrumental in helping establish the Snohomish County Assembly in the state of Washington. The Patriotic Network of Franklin County adopted the same organizational model.

A small group of Franklin County residents began meeting and formed the Executive Committee. This committee established by-laws and set in motion a plan to create a network of like-minded people within our county to educate the public about our rights, to safeguard our liberties, to pray for those elected or appointed to public office to make decisions that conform to God’s plan, and to call attention to officials, policies, and pretended legislation that infringe upon our liberties and contradict God’s Laws. The Patriotic Network held its first Meeting of the Whole in March of 2021.

The Network established various committees to handle tasks such as:

- Committee of Safety
- Safety and Local Government Oversight
- Communication
- Emergency Preparedness and Community Organization

The Network has hosted speakers on various current topics of interest. They have also provided free training classes on topics such as:

- The Duty of the Juror
- Self Defense
- Emergency Preparedness
- Gardening
- Emergency Medical Procedures

Executive Committee meetings are held weekly to plan upcoming events. County residents are encouraged to attend the monthly Meeting of the Whole, which is held the first Tuesday of every month at the Callaway Church of God at 6:30 pm. 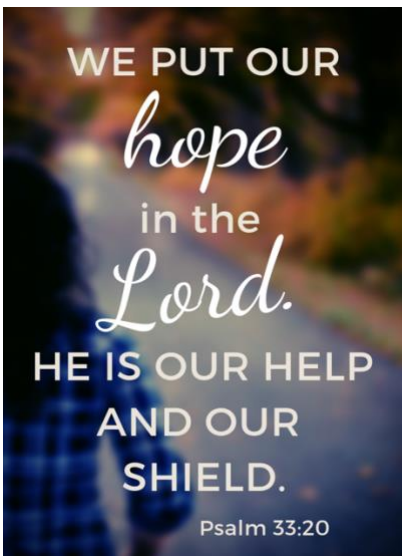

Safeguarding Franklin County's Most Precious Resource: Our Children

One of the Committees of the Patriotic Network is the Committee of Safety. Included among the duties of this committee are watching for Constitutional violations by local governing bodies, attending school board meetings, and monitoring classroom content and teaching techniques.

As members of this group began monitoring the decisions of our local school board, certain issues infringing upon the rights of our children and the will of the people in our community became apparent. These issues included the reluctance to re-open schools after the COVID-19 shut down, poor performance of students, graduation rates affected by online instruction and the lack of classroom instruction, mask policies, teaching through the lens of Critical Race Theory, and new bathroom and locker room policies.

Members of the Patriotic Network of Franklin County (PNFC) have attended school board meetings for the last several months. At least seven of our members have voiced concerns via public comment to the board members. The PNFC partnered with the Children's Advocacy Alliance of Virginia to voice concerns and seek changes in the school board's policies and composition.

The June meeting hosted a crowd of concerned citizens with standing room only, and the July meeting left as many members standing outside in the heat and humidity as were seated inside the boardroom. Arlet Greer, the Blackwater school board representative made a motion to hold future school board meetings in a larger venue. This motion was quickly shot down on the premise the public would not continue to be interested or attend meetings since any discussion of

some of the controversial topics mentioned above were finished.

At the July school board meeting, 48 citizens addressed the board with speakers being concerned with masking our children and Critical Race Theory / Cultural Competency concerns. Endangering students, both transgendered and gendered, by following state and federal pretend legislation concerning restrooms and locker rooms was also a hot topic. To date, four school divisions in Virginia have decided they will not follow the new restroom policies.

The Children's Advocacy Alliance of Virginia and the Patriotic Network of Franklin County encourage citizens to continue to attend school board meetings and voice their concerns and to take a stand against tyrannical mandates from state and federal agencies.
